INTRODUCTION

• ORGANZATION: FIFA

- Promote the game of Association Football [...], to foster friendly relations among National Association, Confederations, and their officials and players, by promoting the organization of football matches at all levels, and to control every type of association football by taking steps as shall be deemed necessary or advisable"
- EVENT: 2022 FIFA WORLD CUP
 - Occurs once every four years, host selected by FIFA years in advance,
- CRISIS #1: BACK LASH OVER QATAR HOSTING
- CRISIS #2: CORRUPTION

BACKGROUND-QATAR & FIFA

- Qatar hosted the 2022 FIFA World Cup
- Controversial pick due to- corruption/ bribery, workers' rights, cultural beliefs
- Corruption/ bribery
- Workers' rights
- Cultural beliefs





Problem Identification



LOGISTICS - INFASTRCURE, CLIMATE, REGULATIONS

- World Cup Typically Hosted in Summer » moved to Winter b/c of Qatar's climate
- Smallest country to ever host
- Lack of Infrastructure » underwent massive construction projects in preparation
- Strict Alcohol Regulations » Drinking and being drunk in public is punishable by jail time and fines, two days before kick-off the Qatari royal family announced that alcohol would be banned from stadiums despite originally saying they would allow it





HUMAN RIGHTS - LGBT+, WORKERS, EXPRESSION

- **Discrimination** » Sex between men is punishable by up to seven years in prison, men who "instigate" or "entice" another man to commit "an act of sodomy or immorality" could face imprisonment (Sullivan, 2022).
- Oppressive Labor System (Kafala) » states give employers sponsorship permits to bring in foreign workers, which bind workers to their employers and allow for exploitation" (Cholewinski, 2023).
 - more than 6,500 foreign workers lost their lives –
 Guardian Report
- Expression » citizens & media are not allowed to criticize Qatar government or politically rally against it (Saafein, 2022).
 - Fans wearing rainbow clothing were prevented from entering the stadium





CORRUPTION - SPORTS WASHING, BRIBERY

- Organizational Misconduct » Sepp Blatter (president of FIFA) suspended by FIFA's ethics committee, received a guilty verdict with charges of ethics violation
 - o accusations of bribing board members w/\$50,000+ each if they voted for him (Saafein, 2022).
 - allegations of accepting monetary bribes in exchange for awarding the 2018 and 2022 World Cup Finals to Russia and Qatar, respectively
- **Sportswashing** » Use of a sporting event by a government to improve their reputation
 - Popularity & the passion that fans have for the sport (soccer) is harnessed by a state (Qatar) as a tool to improve both international & domestic relations (boost tourism, revenue, & Qatar's reputation.)

CONCERN: FIFA ADDRESSED
CONCERNS SURROUNDING LGBTQ+
RIGHTS

- FIFA WORKED WITH QATAR TO LET INDIVIDUALS ATTENDING THE GAME IN AND OUT OF THE STADIUM
- ALLOWED DISPLAYS OF LGBTQ+ RIGHTS IN THE STADIUM





CONTROL: FIFA WAS ABLE TO CONTROL THE MEDIA NARRATIVE

- FOCUSED MEDIA ATTENTION ON SOMETHING SMALLER
 - BUDWEISER IS THE OFFICIAL BEER OF THE WORLD CUP IN A COUNTRY THAT DOESN'T ALLOW ALCOHOL RESULTING IN ZERO PERCENT ALCOHOL BEER
- TAKING THE ATTENTION AWAY FROM THE HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATION CONTROVERSIES





COMMITMENT: FIFA LAUNCHES
A SUSTAINABILITY
MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (SMS)

• CREATING NEW STADIUMS WITH ENERGY AND WATER-EFFICIENT IRRIGATION SYSTEMS WHILE MINIMIZING FIFA'S CARBON FOOTPRINT

OUTCOME: PLAYERS SIGNED A LETTER TO FIFA, STATING THAT FIFA'S CARBON CALCULATIONS WERE FLAWED AND THAT FIFA WAS SHIFTING THE RESPONSIBILITY TO FANS





ETHICAL CONSIDERATIONS

Carbon Neutral Claim

- Construction of the stadium didnt reach carbon neutral target
- Calculations underestimated amount produced
- Didn't purchase enough carbon offsets
- Gives the impression of dishonesty, misleads the public that the event was sustainable

Reparations

- Did not follow through on paying reparations to families of workers killed in construction
- Bare minimum to rectify the situation
- Gives the public the impression they're not apologetic
